HOWARD COUNTY- According to Howard County Police, two cars collided on state Route 32 near U.S. Route 29 at about 8:46 p.m. yesterday.

62-year-old Mary Ann Cecile Levant of Columbia, MD, collided with 32-year-old Bob Smith of Hyattsville, MD, when she lost control of her vehicle. Levant was driving east on state Route 32, also known as the Patuxent Freeway. After losing control of her car, she struck the guardrail of the right shoulder of the road. This caused her 2015 Toyota Avalon to bounce off the guard off and into on-coming traffic. Smith, also going east on the Patuxent Freeway, collided the crashed vehicle in his 2012 Honda Civic. Police say it was raining and foggy at the time of the accident. It is unclear what caused Levant to lose control of her vehicle. No deaths or injuries were reported. It is not confirmed where on the Patuxent Freeway the accident took place, but sources say it was near the intersection of U.S. Route 29, just outside of Columbia, MD.
